

Point Scale Evaluation

This school year the Spanish lessons for grades 5th thru 8th will be graded using a point scale approach. This scale is established to develop more interest and effort from the Junior High students toward learning a different language, in this case Spanish.

During the school year, the students will be completing different class-work that will be scored from 1 thru 5, depending on the level of difficulty. By the end of each semester (2nd and 4th quarter), those points will be added up and averaged with the maximum points possible. Students that accumulated a total of $\frac{3}{4}$ or more of the maximum points possible will earn a High Pass Score (HP), students that accumulated a total of $\frac{1}{4}$ or more but less than $\frac{3}{4}$ will earn a Pass Score (P). Any score less than $\frac{1}{4}$ of the maximum points possible will represent a fail score (F).

For example: Maximum possible points: 40 $\frac{3}{4}$ = 30 points 40-30 points = High Pass (HP)
 $\frac{1}{4}$ = 10 points 10-29 points = Pass (P)
9 points or less = Fail (F)

I will do my best to post the points earned in Grade Book, in a timely manner, so students and parents can keep track of their progress!

Hopefully, with this approach and the students' effort we will have a successful year!
